

CLASS REGISTRATION

Registration requires paying 1st Tuition Installment + annual membership fee (\$39 student /\$75 family max). This will be charged to your card on file to complete your class registration.

TUITION

Tuition fees are paid over 10 installments on the 10th of each month or annually. Tuition rates are for the full season (including studio breaks) from Aug. 19 through the Spring Recital in May (not by the number of classes in the month). A full season of dance includes a minimum of 33-weeks of programming including rehearsals and recital weeks. Emailed notice 30 days in advance is required to withdraw from a class.

DISCOUNTS

Siblings receive a 10% discount on the smaller tuition account for regular school year classes. No sibling discounts are offered for summer classes, Momentum Company, mini-sessions, music, special events or quest artists.

CLASSES

- Maranatha reserves the right to reschedule or combine classes or to provide a substitute.
- Maranatha reserves the right to deliver class content via an online system in the event that classes are not able to be conducted live for any reason including, but not limited to: weather, teacher absence, or governmental advisory.

PERFORMANCES

Recital Showcase

We celebrate our end of season in May with our Recital Showcase (all classes except Leveled Ballet).

Recital Costs:

- Recital Costume (includes tights, accessories, and garment bag): \$89 per class. \$84 Preschool.
- Recital fee: \$89 per family (Recital fee includes 2-free tickets, recital video, souvenir, & more)
- Additional Tickets: available for purchase online before each show.

Recital schedules, locations and other information will be published in the spring.

Our annual Ballet Recital for our Level 1 - 6 & Teen Ballet will have more information announced soon.

PAYMENT

- The dance season starts Aug. 19 and runs through the Recital Showcase in May.
- · After registering, tuition installments may be paid by check, cash, debit, or credit card payment, All accounts are required to keep a credit card on file. Payments may be made in-person between the 1st & 10th of each month. Tuition will auto-charge on the 10th of each month. Credit and Debit card payments will incur a 3.5% convenience fee across all payment platforms. Each account is required to have a card on file.
- There is a \$20 fee on NSF accounts and a 5% fee on late accounts.
- · Costume and Recital fees will be auto-charged using your automatic payment method, but may be paid prior to the charge date using other methods.

ATTIRE

Proper attire is required for all classes. Attire should be modest and professional. Bare midriffs, ultra short shorts, and tops that show cleavage or undergarments should not be worn to class. No large iewelry items. No socks without shoes.

Preschool & Children's Dress Code:

Dance with Me, Tippy Toes, Tutus & Bowties: Any color skirted leotard or leotard with shorts, footless tights, no shoes.

Ballet Kids, Primary Ballet: Any color leotard, skirt, tights, and pink ballet shoes.

Acro Kids, Primary Acro: Leotard, shorts or leggings, no

Primary Tap: Any color leotard, leggings or tights with shorts, and black tap shoes.

Musical Theater: Any color leotard, leggings or tights with shorts, tan jazz shoes.

Hip Hop Kids, Primary Hip Hop: Any color leotard, leggings or sweatpants (no shorts), clean soled sneakers, T-Shirts allowed over leotard.

Hair: Ponytail, Braid, or Bun (hair must be pulled back)

Boys: Athletic Pants & T-shirt, genre appropriate shoes.

Leveled & Teen Dress Code:

Ballet: Black leotard, black skirt, pink or black tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in a tidy bun.
