Burkina Faso School Update





A Lifeline for the Community

Love Does and Lifeline Christian Mission just recently sent their third shipping container of food to the Love Does school in Burkina Faso. These shipping containers contain boxes of rice based meal kits. The school utilizes these meals to provide lunch for each child that attends school, and for some this is the only meal that they will receive that day.

Pastor Deme and the Love Does School also distribute this food to families in the community. This food distribution provides an opportunity for Pastor Deme and the staff to share God's love in a tangible way with many members of the surrounding community of different faith backgrounds that they would not normally have an opportunity to interact with.

These shipping containers of food not only bless the surrounding community, but they also provide building expansions for the school. The school has converted two of the containers into administrative offices, allowing more educational space in the current buildings.
