packing checklist

**Be sure items are labeled with your name!*

- Maranatha swag! Warmup jacket, t-shirt, etc
- Hair necessities (pulled back & professional for all classes)
- 2-3 leotards
- 2-3 pairs of tights
- Bible and journal
- Camera (phones should be in airplane mode or off during class)
- Food for breakfast, lunch, and snacks
- Costume pieces for Showcase, if performing
- Dance Bag with:
 - Jazz shoes
 - Ballet shoes
 - Hip Hop sneakers (jazz shoes can also be worn in Hip Hop class)
 - Socks (no grip compression are great for dancing on carpet!)
 - Refillable water bottle
 - Leggings, dance shorts, ballet skirt
 - Tank tops or t-shirts
 - Extra hair ties, bobby pins
- Attire for "Flower Power" Dance Party (Friday night)- Pack all things Tropical! Think florals, bright colors, butterflies, be creative!
- *Parents: Consider bringing a sweater or jacket. The ballrooms are kept very cool for the comfort of the dancers!*

During classes, wear your leotard, tights and genre-appropriate attire. Dancers **MUST** be wearing a leotard base layer for all classes. No midriffs or cleavage, please! Ballet dress code for ballet classes is appreciated.

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Students in the Apprentice, Junior, Teen and Senior level have an opportunity to win a scholarship to one DR tour location which must be used by the end of the next tour season. Students can sign up and wear a number on the front of their body for Saturday and Sunday classes.

PLEASE BE RESPECTFUL OF THE DANCE REV REQUIREMENTS

- You must purchase a Video Class Pass if you plan on recording any classes. DR will have a professional videographer for all other major events that will be made available to order. You will not be allowed to tape Friday night, during the Showcase, Production or Faculty Show.
- Wristbands must be worn at all times. Students may only dance in their designated ballroom. Observers will not be allowed into teacher classes. There is no charge for children as Observers under 6 years old.
- Students wanting to change levels must do so within the first three classes of the convention and with the permission of the student's studio director.
- Cover ups must be worn outside of ballrooms at all times. Modest dress at all times is required.
