CLASS DESCRIPTIONS - PRESCHOOL AND CHILDRENS

Our Preschool and Children's teaching staff follow the Discover Dance curriculum by Andrea Trench. Discover Dance is an educational platform and early childhood dance program focusing on research-based, developmentally appropriate content for young and recreational dancers. Each teacher follows a curriculum scope and sequence that provides each dancer specific movement goals, dance terminology, technique, and dance concepts to achieve based on age and dance genre.



Dance With Me is a unique class designed for little ones and their caregivers to dance, laugh, and make lasting memories together! Through movement activities and music, this class encourages bonding, creativity, and joy. This non-recital class is perfect for young dancers who aren't quite ready to dance alone.



Ballet Kids is for dancers in Kindergarten & 1st Grade who are ready to take the next step in their ballet journey! In this class, dancers wear ballet shoes for the first time and begin focusing on proper ballet technique and terminology in a fun, age-appropriate way. With a mix of structure and creativity, Ballet Kids helps build strength, grace, and a strong foundation for future dance training.



Children's Musical Theater Dance is where dancing and acting come together for an experience full of fun and creativity! Dancers will learn high energy choreography inspired by Broadway's best while exploring character, storytelling, and stage presence. Perfect for kids who love to perform, this class builds imagination, expression, and teamwork—all while having a blast!



Our high-energy Elementary tap class is perfect for kids who love to make music with their feet! Dancers learn tap steps, rhythms, and combinations that build coordination, timing, and tons of confidence. With every shuffle, stomp, and step, they'll be smiling, moving, and making noise in the best way possible!





Tippy Toes is the perfect first dance class for our dancers ages 3-4! With twirls, giggles, and lots of fun, dancers begin to learn about creative movement in a playful and encouraging environment. This class is also their very first independent dance class and recital experience—building confidence, making new friends, and creating magical memories on stage!



Primary Ballet is designed for dancers in 2nd - 5th Grade who are ready to deepen their ballet training. CLASS REGISTRATION

Registration requires paying 1st Tuition Installment + annual membership fee (\$39 student /\$75 family max). This will be charged to your card on file to complete your class registration.

TUITION

Tuition fees are paid over 10 installments on the 10th of each month or annually. Tuition rates are for the full season (including studio breaks) from Aug. 18 through the Spring Recital in May (not by the number of classes in the month). A full season of dance includes a minimum of 33-weeks of programming including rehearsals and recital weeks. Emailed notice 30 days in advance is required to withdraw from a class.

DISCOUNTS

Siblings receive a 10% discount on the smaller tuition account for regular school year classes. No sibling discounts are offered for summer classes, Momentum Company, Elevate workshops, minisessions, music, special events, guest artists, or conventions.

Recital Costs:

PAYMENT

- The dance season starts Aug. 18th and runs through May.
- Registration requires paying 1st Tuition Installment + annual membership fee (\$39 student /\$75 family max). This will be charged to your card on file to complete your class registration. Notify the desk by email prior to registration if you need to make payment using a different method.
- After registration, tuition installments may be paid by check, cash, debit, or credit card payment, All accounts are required to keep a credit card on file. Payments may be made in-person between the 1st & 10th of each month. Tuition will auto-charge on the 10th of each month.
- Credit and Debit card payments will incur a 3.5% convenience fee across all payment platforms.
 There is a \$20 fee on NSF accounts and a 5% fee on late accounts.
- Costume and Recital fees will be auto-charged using your automatic payment method, but may be paid prior to the charge date using other methods.



ATTIRE

Proper attire is required for all classes. Attire should be modest and professional. Bare midriffs, ultra short shorts, and tops that show cleavage or undergarments should not be worn to class. No large jewelry items. No socks without shoes.

Preschool & Children's Dress Code:

<u>Dance with Me, Tippy Toes, Tutus & Bowties:</u> Any color skirted leotard or leotard with shorts, footless tights, no shoes.

<u>Ballet Kids, Primary Ballet</u>: Any color leotard, skirt, tights, and pink ballet shoes.

<u>Acro Kids, Primary Acro</u>: Leotard, shorts or leggings, no shoes.

<u>Elementary Tap & Jazz</u>: Any color leotard, leggings or tights with shorts, and tap/jazz shoes. Tan shoes will be requested for recital.

<u>Musical Theater</u>: Any color leotard, leggings or tights with shorts, tan jazz shoes.

<u>Hip Hop Kids, Primary Hip Hop</u>: Any color leotard, leggings or sweatpants (no shorts), clean soled sneakers. T-Shirts allowed over leotard. Specific color sneakers will be requested for recital.

Hair: Ponytail, braid, or bun (hair must be pulled back).

Boys: Athletic Pants & T-shirt, genre appropriate shoes.

Leveled & Teen Dress Code:

<u>Ballet</u>: Girls- black leotard, pink tights, ballet skirt, pink ballet shoes, hair in slick tidy bun.

Boys- black or white t-shirt, black athletic shorts, white socks. black ballet shoes.

<u>Jazz/Lyrical</u>: Any color leotard, tights, form fitting shirts or shorts may be worn over leotard, hair in slick tidy bun or twist. Jazz shoes (tan or black may be required for recital); Lyrical turners (required for recital for level 1-3). Barefoot or BlochSox for Int and Adv lyrical.

<u>Acro</u>: Any color leotard, shorts or leggings, hair pulled back, no shoes, socks, or jewelry.

<u>Hip Hop</u>: Girls- leotard, t-shirt, sweatpants or leggings, clean-soled sneakers (specific color will be required for recital), no midriffs, no shorts, hair pulled back. Boys- t-shirt, athletic pants, clean-soled sneakers (specific color will be required for recital), no shorts.
